The V Latin American Symposium on Cell Culture Technology (V SLATCC) offers Latin American researchers and professionals, as well as other international participants, the opportunity to share and discuss the results and experiences in the different fields of application of animal cell culture, such as biopharmaceuticals, vaccine production and the use of stem cells.

BACKGROUND

Since 2004, SLATCC has been held every two years and consists of oral presentations, round tables and poster sessions. The first edition was held in the Universidade Federal do Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, where several lecturers presented their main work projects. The following editions were held in Sao Paulo, Brazil (2006), La Habana, Cuba (2008) and Montevideo, Uruguay (2010). All of them showed the achievements made when integrating several work teams in the same field. The next edition will be celebrated in Santa Fe, Argentina and is being organized by the Cell Culture Laboratory of the School of Biochemistry and Biological Sciences (Universidad Nacional del Litoral).
